Coming Sermons

April 2 FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT "What Brings Fulfillment?" John 13:1-5, 13-17

Jesus taught us that service to others is a key ingredient of a rewarding life. By taking on the role of a servant and washing his disciples' feet, Jesus shows us that true fulfillment comes from caring for others. Self-absorbed people who live only for themselves and their immediate family will never be content.

April 9 PALM SUNDAY "Praise God" Luke 19:28-40

Today is Palm Sunday, a day on which Jesus' followers showed their love and appreciation for him. Although we may all have different thoughts about what "worship" should look like, it is basically just a way of expressing our love and appreciation for God.

April 16 EASTER SUNDAY "What Gives Us Hope?" Matthew 28:1-7

The message of Easter is a message of hope. The last words of the Gospel are not about crucifixion and death, but about resurrection and life. The resurrection of Jesus Christ tells us that God is in the business of bringing life out of death, hope out of despair. Easter gives us hope for the living, and even hope for the dying.
