I was reading recently from the book of Philippians and this passage stood out to me:

For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases Him. (Philippians 2:13 NLT)

I don't know about you, but I do always have the desire to do what pleases God. Sometimes we simply want to do our own thing. But God has a plan and wants us on-board with Him. He will keep nudging our hearts and minds and attitudes and, be it ever so slowly, He will help us develop the desire to do what pleases Him. And once we finally have that desire, He will then give us the power to put the desire into action.

It's not always easy to do what God wants us to. Sometimes it requires sacrifice. Sometimes it requires that we do things that are outside our comfort zone. Sometimes it requires us to develop new skills. Sometimes it requires us to develop new habits. It's not always easy to find the desire to do these things. And even if we want to, it is not always easy to have the strength to actually do them. But God is working on us and He won't give up on us. He wants to help us develop the desire and then He will give us the strength.

There is just one catch: we must be willing! Let me encourage you to make a commitment to God. Tell God that you are willing to develop the desire to do what pleases Him. If you are willing, God can take it from there and help you with the rest of the task. He can and will help you become the person He wants you to be if you let him. Are you willing?
